APPROVING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND ADOPTING THE MITIGATION MONITORING PROGRAM FOR THE PALM SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL SEISMIC UPGRADES AND MODERNIZATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT AND THE CALIFORNIA EDUCATION CODE; APPROVING THE PROJECT, AND DELEGATION OF AUTHORITTY TO STAFF TO EXECUTE THE NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

RESOLUTION NO. 2019/2020-14

WHEREAS, the Palm Springs Unified School District ("District") desires to implement various seismic upgrades and modernization improvements on the Palm Springs High School ("PSHS") campus situated across a total area of approximately 43 acres located at 2401 East Baristo Road and immediately adjoins the Desert Learning Academy; and

WHEREAS, prior to implementing various seismic upgrades and modernization improvements, the District must comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (Pub. Res. Code section 21000 et seq.) ("CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, Meridian Consultants, in conjunction with District staff, has prepared an Initial Study and a Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND"), State Clearinghouse No. 2019109008, pursuant to CEQA to identify significant environmental impacts, if any, associated with the implementation of various seismic upgrades and modernization improvements of the Palm Springs High School ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the MND was prepared pursuant to CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the District, as the lead agency for the Project, provided copies of the draft MND ("Draft MND") and Initial Study to the public for review and comment pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 21091 and 21092, beginning October 3, 2019 and ending November 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully reviewed the MND and Initial Study and all other relevant information contained in the record for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received and considered comments received from the public and other interested agencies regarding the MND and Initial Study; and

WHEREAS, the MND includes mitigation measures which, if adopted, will mitigate the impacts of the Project to a level of insignificance; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Final MND is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, all other legal prerequisites to the adoption of the Resolution have occurred; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of the District hereby finds, determines, declares, orders and resolves as follows:

- <u>Section 1 Recitals</u>. That all of the recitals set forth above are true and correct, and the Board so finds and determines.
- Section 2 Compliance with CEQA. That the Board reviewed and considered the information contained in the MND including without limitation, the Draft MND, Initial Study, comments from the public and interested agencies, and any comments made at the public hearing or contained in the administrative record for the Projects and the Mitigation Monitoring Program ("Final MND"). The Board hereby makes the following specific findings with respect to the Final MND:
- (a) That the Final MND prepared for the Project contains a complete and accurate reporting of the environmental impacts associated with the Project; and
- (b) That the Final MND has been completed in compliance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines; and
- (c) That the Project as designed, and with incorporated mitigation measures, will not result in significant effects upon the environment; and
- (d) That there is no substantial evidence in the record supporting a fair argument that the Projects may result in significant impacts to the environment; and
 - (e) That the Final MND reflects the independent judgment of the District; and
- (f) The Board hereby makes and adopts the Mitigation Measures attached to the Final MND as **Exhibit** "B" thereto, which incorporates into the Project all mitigation measures set forth therein and approves and authorizes the implementation of the Mitigation Measures; and
- (g) That any mitigation measures added to the Final MND subsequent to the circulation of the Draft MND, if any, are either minor changes to the Project and do not result in a fundamental reorganization of the MND, and/or the purpose of the mitigation measures are to reduce the effects on the environment that were already identified in the Draft MND as insignificant, and further that the mitigation measures do not have the potential to have a significant impact upon the environment; and

(h) That any mitigation measures which have been changed or substituted subsequent to the circulation of the Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, if any, are equivalent or more effective in mitigating the environmental impacts then the prior mitigation measures, and that the change and/or substitution of such mitigation measures and not itself cause any potentially significant effect upon the environment.

Section 3 - Location and Custodian of Records. The location and custodian of records with respect to all of the relevant documents and any other material which constitutes the administrative record for the Mitigated Negative Declaration are as

Section 7. Approval of Project. That the Project, as described and analyzed in the Final MND, is hereby approved.
